FAQ

1. How can I register for the camp?
Use the attached registration form and mail it along with your deposit.
2. When is the registration deadline?
The deadline for signing up for the camp is February 28, 2009.
3. What forms must I fill out for the camp?
You will fill out the registration/payment form provided with this email.
4. How will future camp information be distributed to the campers?
Registered campers will receive email updates.
5. How many campers to a room and can I designate another camper to room with?
There are two campers per room. You will be allowed to designate your roommate on the registration form.
6. Can my spouse stay with me at the camp?
Yes. However, you will be charged an additional \$55 per night for the 3 nights of the camp.
7. Will the hotel provide special room rates for the Success Camp if I arrive early or want to stay after the camp is completed?
Any additional arrangements for extended stay will be the responsibility of each camper and can be made by contacting the hotel directly at 713.462.9977 and ask for Heidi Nokes.
8. If I fly to the camp, how will I get back and forth between the hotel and airport?
The hotel does not provide shuttle service. You will need to make arrangements with a public transportation (i.e. taxi).
9. If I drive to the camp, will there be a charge for parking at the site?
There will be no charge for parking at the site.
10. Each day of the camp, how will I get from the hotel to the scrimmage fields?
The camp will provide buses to take the staff and campers to the fields. They will depart at a pre-determined time.
11. When can I check into the hotel?
Check in to the hotel by 1 pm on Thursday, however, your room may not be available for immediate occupancy. At the start of the program on Thursday, there will be an area to store your travel gear if your room is not available.
12. How do I check in upon arrival and check out from the hotel?
Check in at the registration desk for your hotel room. The camp registration desk will have additional materials for you at the time of check-in.
13. When is hotel check out?
Sunday, May 3, 2009 by 12 NOON.
14. When does the camp begin and end?

The camp program begins with a scrimmage at 4 pm on Thursday. We should conclude on Saturday by 2:30PM. Sunday activity is limited to check-out and departure.

15. When working on the field, do I wear full uniform?
All scrimmages will be in full uniform.
16. How many snaps will I see during my time on the field?
It is estimated that you will be involved in at least 50-60 snaps.
17. How will I receive feedback or evaluation from the staff?
You will receive direct feed back during the scrimmages from staff assigned to your crew each day. In addition, your crew will be taped at one scrimmage and will then have your performance reviewed by a staff member. Additionally, your crew will have another evaluation session with a staff member who will provide a compilation of observations from comments gathered from all staff members who observed your crew during the camp.
18. Will there be classroom instruction and where will the meetings take place?
During the camp, there will be classroom discussions on various aspects of the game. The discussions will be held at the hotel and the field.
19. What happens if I miss the bus from the hotel during the camp?
You will be responsible for your own method of transportation to the field. Accountability and promptness is required.
