


INFORMATION REGARDING CHANGE TO THE DISCUSSION FORUM

The Chapter discussion forum has been hosted for many years now by a company called EZBOARD. Over the past year, that company has been transitioning all its hosted discussion boards to something called YUKU.. Our forum has now been migrated over to YUKU and this might be causing log in problems for some folks.

Whatever user name and password you used previously will still work under YUKU. The actual URL is : <http://safootball.yuku.com> However, if you type the previous URL in, you will automatically be redirected to the correct URL unless you have some browser settings or security software that prevents auto redirects. If you so, then you will need to put the above URL in your browser address box to get to it.

We do not have access to your password so if you have forgotten it you can request it through YUKU. They will send it to the email address you used when you registered. If you no longer have access to that email, you will need to create a new user name/profile with a current email address.
